Fiber Travels in India with Marilyn Romatka DVD via Zoom

In the comfort of our own homes, we will watch *The Handicrafts of Gujarat* DVD. Marilyn Romatka describes her documentary/travelogue this way:

"India. The word alone conjures up images of vivid color and pungent spice. The handicrafts one finds there are stunning. Here is your chance to explore many of the skilled craftspersons that make up this national legacy. Follow along with the weaver and the photographer, as they probe the variety of hand-skills in of one of the most artistic states in India: Gujarat."

JANUARY MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 10:45 AM by President Jill Robinson.

The annual Roc Day meeting was held via Zoom in response to pandemic levels. Jill began by thanking Val Bechteler for hosting all our Zoom meetings.

The Treasurer, in absentia, reported we have a balance of \$5,467.47.

We will be passing the signup sheet for treats and hostesses again as soon as we return to meeting at the church.

Jill reminded everyone to start collecting and planning on items for the Guild Auction, which is scheduled for March but may be held in May, depending on the pandemic.

Jill also reminded everyone who works with carders, wool combs, and raw fleece of the importance of keeping one's tetanus vaccine up to date.

This was followed by an explanation of Roc Day. The name comes from the German word "Rocken" for distaff. It is also known as St Distaff's Day. It came from the European Medieval Catholic practice of celebrating the female workers' return to spinning after Epiphany. The ploughmen started a day later. Jill explained how essential spinning was based on the pervasiveness of the words for distaff used to describe women's spheres.

Finally, this is an election year. Since elections are held in May, there is time for anyone thinking about becoming more involved in the day-to-day work of the guild to consider becoming an officer.
