## **OCTOBER MEETING**

President Jill Robinson opened the meeting at 10:25 AM with a welcome and a reminder to wear nametags. Jill also reminded everyone of the sign-up sheet for hostess and treats and explained those duties. Hostess duties include coming early to help set up chairs and tables as needed, bring creamer and to make coffee.

**Treasury:** the current balance is \$6551.16.

**Membership:** dues are \$20 per year. See Sue Jones to pay or to check your status. Dues must be paid by October if participating in the workshop, or November to no longer receive guild communications.

**CNY Fiber Producers**, who run the CNY festival at the Herkimer County fairgrounds in Frankfort (used to be at Bouckville) usually gets a Sponsor donation from us this time of year. Previously, it was \$100. Kathie Piirak moved that we renew at \$100. The motion was seconded and passed without opposition.

Nicole Massenzio had two announcements:

- 1) On November 22, from 9AM to 9PM, a **Crochetathon** is scheduled at the Salt City Market in Syracuse to make hats to be dispersed to the unhoused.
- 2) **Sarah's Guest House** ([sarahsquesthouse.org](http://sarahsquesthouse.org)) is looking for donations of quilts, preferably on the small side, to be hung on the walls. This non-profit provides lodging and support for those families from out of town receiving medical care in Syracuse.

**Rhinebeck Report:** Members who attended reported perfect sweater weather. Several wore their sweaters made from the previous year's finds. And there were, to this Recording Secretary, cryptic references to "hot pants", a report of a "walton", and discussion as to the merits of sweaters worn by this year's attendees vs other years.

Art Rage sent a very grateful letter thanking us for our sponsorship of two upcoming shows.

Jill announced this month's fiber distribution. It is **Perendale**. This wool comes in relatively long blocky locks. The fiber can be as long as 7" but mostly is 4" to 6". Unlike many other long wools, Perendale has a fairly crisp bouncy crimp. This fiber was distributed unwashed in two oz lots. Jill recommends washing to maintain the lock structure and challenged us to try spinning the wool from the lock.

The meeting closed at 11:03AM and was followed by the always inspiring Show and Tell.
