DECEMBER MEETING

President Jill Robinson called the meeting to order at 10:25am. She reminded everyone to wear their name tags.

Christina Tartaro is collecting donated items for several groups today—see her with yours.

Treasury: the balance is \$5,539.49

Budget: Expense summary for 12/1/24 to 12/1/25 is:

- Breed studies-\$843.90

- Donations (including Church) - \$1,604.92
- Classes - \$1,412.99
- General expenses - \$277.48
- Frolic - \$197.83
- Subscriptions - \$145.00

This year's donations:

- Grace Episcopal Church- Previous donation in lieu of rent has been \$500 for several years. Meg Welch moved to be increased to \$600 to reflect the church's increasing expenses and services to our guild. The motion was seconded and passed without opposition.
- State Fair prizes: Sue Jones moved that we continue to sponsor two prizes at \$25 each. The motion was seconded and passed without opposition.
- Heifer International: In the past we have voted for \$250 for the general donation and \$275 for the Educate a Girl fund. Marcia Snyder moved that we continue as before. The motion was seconded and passed without opposition.
- Adopt an Elder: Previously we donated \$100. Paz Zait-Givon moved that we do the same this year. The motion was seconded and passed without opposition.
- CNY Fiber Arts Producers: A \$100 amount was authorized by a vote at a previous meeting.

We received an email inviting one and all to join the Black Sheep Guild's annual Roc Day celebration. Jill gave a brief explanation of Roc Day for newer members.

Business Cards: Joyce Lock has been working on GFSS business cards in lieu of bookmarks and half sheets to distribute at festivals and demonstrations. The card has a QR code that can transport smart phone owners to the website for the usual information. There was a discussion as to how many to get and how much to spend. Meg Welch then moved that we authorize spending of up to \$50 worth of cards. The motion was seconded and passed without opposition.

Joan Snyder relayed thanks to members who donated items for baskets for a benefit for a local cancer patient. Per Marilee, we have a new member as a result!

Art Rage Traditional Palestinian Embroidered Thobe Exhibition which we sponsored. Several members attended the opening and bubbled over with praise for the exquisite workmanship and art shown in these garments. The show will be open until January 17th.
